



Terms of Use

ONE and NEO are platforms that provide unified, secure access to a group of digital services and resources. Users may access different services and resources depending on their profile.

1. Terms of Access

Any User in the school community may gain access to the Platform after first agreeing to these Terms of Use. If the User is a minor, the express approval of one of the User's parents or legal guardians is required. The School then decides which services each User will be given access to, depending on the School's educational goals and its technical capabilities. The right of Users to access the Platform is individual, non-transferable and is dependent on the User's affiliation with the School's educational community.

Access to the Platform is subject to the prior identification of the User, who must have a strictly individual, confidential username and password. Under no circumstances may this username and password be communicated to a third party. The User is responsible for safeguarding them and for any possible use of them. The User agrees to alert the Platform manager of any anomalies, losses or attempted breaches regarding his or her login information. The User agrees to never leave his or her computer unattended before signing out of the Platform. The User will therefore be held responsible for any negligence.

2. Compliance with Legislation and the Rules of Etiquette

The User agrees to comply with the French laws in effect (see below) and with the French code of good practice regarding the use of digital communication and publication tools. In particular, the laws concerning:

- Literary and artistic property;
- Data protection and the freedom of information;
- The protection of privacy and the right of personal portrayal;
- Human rights, insofar as the User agrees not to send messages that are racist, pornographic, pedophilic, insulting or libelous in nature and agrees not to share criminal content, more generally speaking.

3. Proper Use and the Code of Conduct

The User is responsible for his or her use of the Platform. The User agrees not to intentionally impair the Platform's operations. The User agrees to make rational, fair use of the Platform's services with respect for the rules of etiquette in order to prevent the saturation of the system and to avoid the misuse of the services for commercial or publicity purposes.



4. Monitoring

The law requires that a log be kept of Platform access. In other words, all Platform activity must be documented. In case of a malfunction or breach, this data may be analyzed.

5. Non-Compliance with the Rules

Personal data is the responsibility of the school Principal.

The User has the right to ask the Principal for access to his or her personal data and correct it, per the French law on data protection and the freedom of information.

6. Non-Compliance with the Rules

Any non-compliance with the rules established or referred to within these Terms of Use may lead to access restrictions, in addition to any possible penalties.
